### Blend

The Grenache are from the oldest part of the Domaine de la Solitude, planted by my great-grandfather at the beginning of last century it is located on the western slope of "La Crau" on a terroir of safre. The Syrahs flourish on the fresh soil of Safre des "Blachieres".

- 65% centennial black Grenache
- 35% Syrah

These two great Terroirs are always vinified separately but only the great years, 5 vintages of the last 10 Secret Reserve is created.

### Vinification & aging

Harvesting is done by hand in 25 kg crates. After a double selection of the best bunches in the vineyard then on a sorting table, the grapes are vinified in all cluster for the Grenache and the Syrahs are destemmed. The vinification takes place in concrete tank. The is carefully aged for 20 months and 45% in barrels. The barrels of exceptional qualities are made from Colbert oak from the french forest of Tronçais. The wine is assembled and refined in Foudre barrel for a year before being bottled without filtration or fining.

### Vintage 2020

Yield of 28 hectoliters / hectare. 1600 bottles, 50 magnums produced.

### Tasting notes

Powerful, elegant and refined wine built for the long guard. Intense nose of blackberry, blackcurrant, worn by empyreumatic notes. The dense mouth of this wine blends beautifully notes of tan, cherry, cedar and continues with an intense and persistent finish.

### Recommendations

- To be drink from now through 20 years after the vintage.
- Service temperature: 16-18 ° C.

*10 Apr, 2024 – Lots of smoke and tar, but also forest berry fruit and floral nuances wrapped around an incredibly powerful structure, and all the concentration to go with that. And then comes the dense and balanced finish that is not a jot domineering. A cuvee of wine from century-old vines of grenache (60%) and syrah (40%) from vineyards on sandy soil. Aged for 15 months in barrel, then aged for another year in foudre. From organically grown grapes. Drink or hold.*
